<p>TBI Evaluation – Civilian.</p> <p>Dr. Alison M. Gordon</p> <p>Dr. Mark L. Gordon is presently working on a military project and is unavailable unless requested per the enrollment application.</p>	\$2,500.00	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Remote blood draw where you walk into a draw center (501) or have your blood drawn at your home or office (502). 2) You will have a comprehensive laboratory testing for Neurosteroids, Neuroactive steroids, trophic hormones, biochemistry, and complete cell count. 3) Initial 4-page report with review of lab results and a suggested treatment protocol. 4) Consult with physicians (In Office, Skype, or Phone) for 60 mins to review the results and discuss your treatment protocol. 5) Upon completion of the consultation a 60-65-page personalized handbook is emailed to you. 6) Arrangements with our office to receive your complete treatment protocol if you are in CA or FL otherwise, we will need your physician to write prescriptions for medication only. 7) 6 months of Monthly Program Questionnaires with follow-up. These are used to monitor responses to your protocol every 30 days.

LEO and FD	\$2,500.00	Same program as above with the cost being subsidized by a partial grant by friends of the practice, military organizations, and the Millennium Health Centers, Inc.
Finasteride Syndrome (PFS)	\$2,500.00	Finasteride damages two separate hormonal pathways in the brain. To date, most approaches to treatment are looking at one pathway. Our success rate has been posted by patients on PFS Blogs.
Average Treatment costs	6 mos.	Approximately \$178.00/month for initial 6 months then approximately \$121.00/month for 6 months. Actual Treatment costs may vary based upon labs and responses to initial treatment.
1 st Follow-up Labs	At 3mos	\$505.00 – 650.00
2 nd Follow-up labs	At 6 mos.	\$825.00 – 990.00
3 rd Follow-up labs	At 12 mos.	\$990.00.00

The first year of assessment and treatment is the costliest and then drops by about 40-60% by year 2 and by another 40-60% in year 3 and thereafter.
